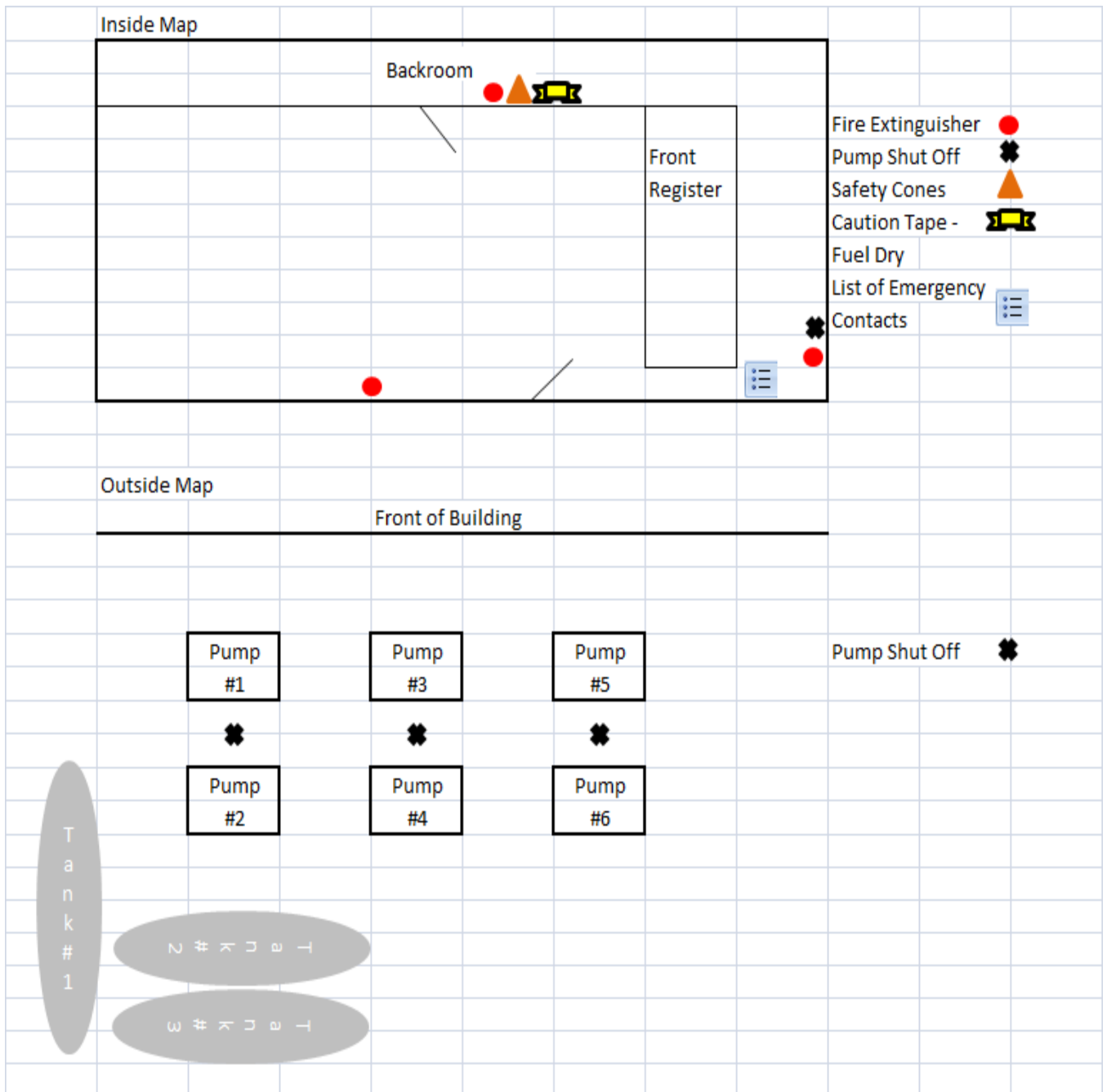

Class C operator of a UST facility is an individual designated by the UST system owner who typically controls the dispensing of fuel at the facility and is responsible for initial response to alarms, releases, spills, overfills or threats to the public or to the environment.

Class C operators must be trained in both general and facility-specific emergency response procedures, such as:

- the operation of emergency shut-off equipment;
- the initial response procedures following system alarm warnings;
- the appropriate first response actions to releases, spills, or overfills; and
- the notification procedures to emergency responders and to the designated Class A and Class B operators of a UST facility.
